Our Level One Program is taught at home by Parents.

You must register for Level One in order to receive the catechetical materials. On completion of Level One your child will begin their study for the Sacrament of Holy Eucharist.

Registration Guidelines:

Copies of our New Student Registration and Continuing Student Registration will be available for printing on our website soon! In the meantime please call our office for registration forms.

If your child is entering First Grade we require a copy of his/her Baptism Certificate.

If you are transferring please provide us with a placement letter from your previous parish.

Tuition and Fees are appreciated at the time of enrollment. The cost of tuition partially covers the cost of catechetical materials, bibles, technology and supplies, workshops for catechists, etc. and are as follows for the 2015 -2016 academic year:

1 child \$75

Family of 2 or more \$100

Sacramental programs are separate and the fees are as follows:

Confirmation Level 9 \$100 / First Communion Level 2 \$100

All of our catechists are volunteers who give so generously of their time. We offer training in classroom management and suggestions and ideas for passing on the faith as well as catechist formation programs. Volunteers must attend a Virtus Training Program (protecting God's children) and adhere to a code of conduct mandated by the Diocese of Rockville Centre.

First Holy Communion will be celebrated on Saturday in May 14th at 11 am.

Confirmation is celebrated on a selected date determined by the Office of the Bishop and will be posted when we receive notification. Here at St. Pat's we like to celebrate the Sacrament on or about our Parish Feast Day, St. Patrick's Day.
